If you use our eFiling portal directly (so you do the data entry and upload the documents) via efile.saylerlegal.com ~ The costs work like this:

You pay the court for all its fees as you go (none of the charges you incur at the time of the filing are from Saylor Legal). You get a receipt emailed to you from the court and you can also review all of your eFiling expenses from the court in the Reports Tab. Once per month we will invoice you \$3.00 per envelope (compared to many of our competitors that start at \$9.95 and up per envelope). If you're invoicing your clients as you go, just add \$3.00 to whatever you were charged by the court to cover our fee.

eServe Opposing Counsel – FREE, as you are performing this act using our portal. Our portal status also reveals when opposing has opened the email that you've sent.

Concierge Service – We can pick up your documents or you can email them to us and we do the data-entry and upload the documents for you. You incur the filing fees/convenience fees charged by the court, and our fee is \$25 per envelope for the first filing of the day, and \$23.50 thereafter that day. We do pay the court's \$3-\$5 transaction fee out of the \$25 (not you).
